KUHS – Exam General (A) - Fixation of fee for Examination Registration of Single Subject integrated OSCE in the Eighth Semester B.Sc. Nursing Degree Examination and fee for Consolidated Mark -cum-Grade Card of B.Sc. Nursing Degree Course (Semester System) – Decision No. 43.18 of the 43rd Board of Examinations - Decision No. 88.32 of the 88th Governing Council – Ratified – Orders issued.

Order

As per the prevailing regulations of the university governing the B.Sc. Nursing (Semester) programme, no theory examinations are conducted in the eighth semester. Instead, a single practical examination, namely Integrated OSCE in Nursing is conducted, covering Adult Health Nursing, Child Health Nursing, Community Health Nursing, Mental Health Nursing, Midwifery/Obstetrics and Gynaecology (OBG) Nursing. The University shall appoint a total of five examiners for the conduct of the said practical examination.

2. Since this is the first occasion on which the University is conducting the Eighth Semester B.Sc. Nursing Degree Examination, no fee has hitherto been prescribed for the registration of the aforesaid practical examination.

3. In the above circumstances, the Honourable Vice Chancellor has accorded sanction to fix the examination registration fee for the single subject practical examination, viz., Integrated OSCE in Nursing of the eighth semester, at Rs.305/- (Rupees Three Hundred and Five only) subject to ratification by the Board of Examinations.

4. In the B.Pharm semester programme, individual semester marklists are not issued in view of the semester pattern of study. Instead, a Consolidated Mark-cum-Grade Card is issued upon successful





completion of the programme. Accordingly, on par with the B.Pharm semester programme, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, vide paper read as 4th above, accorded sanction not to issue individual semester mark lists under the B.Sc. Nursing Semester Scheme. Instead, a Consolidated Mark-cum-Grade Card shall be issued to candidates on successful completion of the programme subject to ratification by the Board of Examinations. As no fee had been prescribed for the issuance of the Consolidated Mark-cum-Grade Card under the B.Sc. Nursing Semester Scheme, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor has also accorded sanction to fix the fee for the same at Rs. 1,890/- (Rupees One Thousand Eight Hundred & Ninety Only), subject to the ratification of the Board of Examinations.

5. The 43rd meeting of the Board of Examinations, after detailed deliberations, vide paper read as 1st above, resolved to ratify the action taken by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor regarding:

1. **Fixation of Rs. 305/- (Rupees Three Hundred and Five only) as the examination registration fee for the single-subject Integrated OSCE in Nursing examination in the Eighth Semester; and**
2. **Fixation of Rs. 1,890/- (Rupees One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety only) as the fee for the issuance of the consolidated mark cum grade card of the B.Sc Nursing Degree programme (Semester System), which is the same as that prescribed for the consolidated mark cum grade card of the B.Pharm Semester programme.**

6. The Finance Committee, after considering the matter, vide paper read as 2nd above, resolved to recommend the Fixation of the Exam registration fee for the Eighth Semester B.Sc. Nursing Degree Examination and the fee for the issuance of the Consolidated Mark cum grade card of the B.Sc. Nursing Degree programme (Semester system) and to place the matter before the Governing Council for ratification.

7. The 88th meeting of the Governing Council, vide paper read as 3rd above, approved the recommendations of the Finance Committee.

8. In light of the above, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor has accorded sanction to implement the aforesaid decision of the Governing Council.

9. Orders are issued accordingly.
